



# How to Organize an Event at Your School

1. Find musicians who attend your school. Can't find them? Try your campus open-mic, your campus a cappella group, your high school choir, or wandering the halls of the music department
2. Secure a venue. Most schools have indoor and outdoor space you can use for free as a student just by signing up
3. Create a Facebook event and invite your friends, classmates and professors
4. Pre-record a video of your message of support for the "Concert Across America to End Gun Violence." Upload it to your Facebook page and/or tweet it out using the hashtags #ConcertAcrossAmerica #EndGunViolence
